



Mentor Coaching

The International Coaching Federation (ICF) defines Mentor Coaching as a process of coaching and feedback provided by a ‘mentor coach’ to a ‘mentee coach’ in a collaborative, appreciative and dialogued manner based on observed or recorded coaching sessions of the ‘mentee coach’. This process is mandated by ICF to increase the coach’s capability in coaching and alignment with ICF Core Competencies.

Who is it for...

Trainee coaches on any of the following learning paths.

- ACSTH
- ACC - ACSTH / Portfolio
- PCC - ACSTH / Portfolio
- ACC/PCC Credential Renewal

How it works...

- The Mentee shares recorded coaching conversations (audio/video) along with a transcript.
- The mentor reviews the call before the mentoring session.
- The mentee and mentor engage in a virtual call (60 mins)
- During the call, the mentor reviews the conversation with the mentee and shares observations, feedback and tips.
- They jointly identify mentee’s strengths and also areas of development.
